

The one thing she can't live without is her family. After graduation, she wants to go to cosmetology school.


Recycling: A “ReNewed” Experience

The eighth grade class recently visited both the recycling center and the Glass ReFactory. Shown above are two areas of the Center: one showing products to be recycled after being sorted and baled, and the other shows the melting of glass before being shaped into a stamped sun-catcher. The staff at the Recycling Center presented students with much “food for thought” as they traveled through the different areas and witnessed the processes for recycling as well as learning the various products and by-products that **can** be recycled.
