

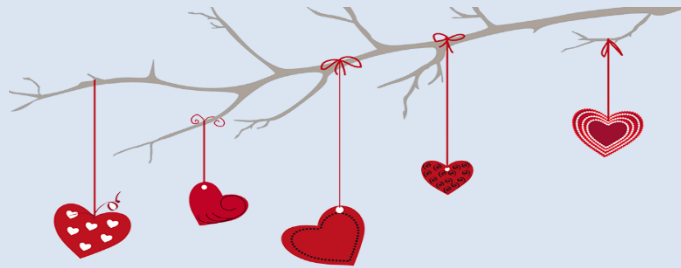

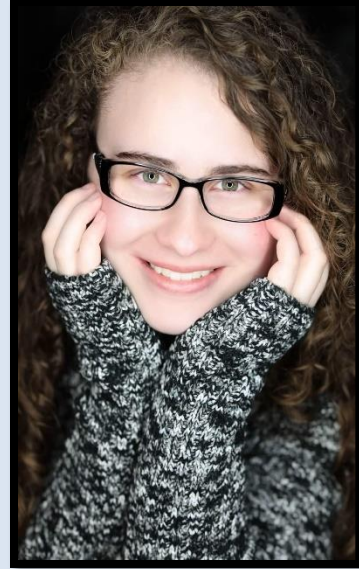
Gage Kinhalt

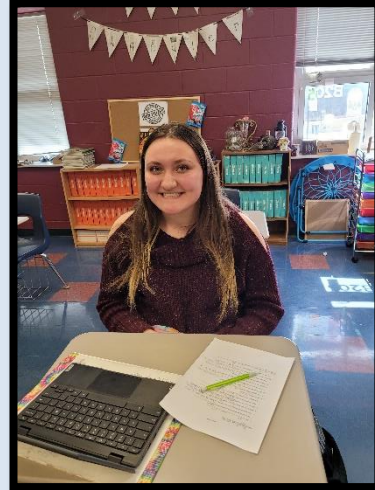
Junior Profiles
