Part one: February or March

Part two: April or May

Tests are Combined for a Single Score

- * Earn at least **4** points in **English** tests
- * Earn at least **4** points in **Math** tests
- * Earn at least **6** points in **Science** and **SS**



Flexibility for Students

High score on one test can balance a low score on another test.

End-of-Course Exam Retakes

Score Below Proficient	Score Proficient or Above
May retake exam after remediation	May only retake any exam after remediation if student has not met overall points total

End-of-Course Exam Retakes

Substitute exams may be used interchangeably – the same rules apply

Students who earned course credit before new state tests automatically receive three points for the subject. They may take the end-of-course exam for a higher score.
