Finally, a Three-Volley salute was performed by 3 local veterans who took 3 shots into the air with their rifles in honor of their fellow fallen soldiers. May these 3 brave men and all men who lost their lives on the battlefield rest in peace.


JV Girls BB


Xander Smith
