With Hannah's score off the block, they defeated the Hounds by 6. The Hounds played Easter Beaver September 20th and once again lost with a running clock.

The Hounds suffered another loss to Peebles, October 4th. At halftime of the Peebles game, the Hounds were only down by 6 points. The final score was Peebles 62, Manchester 28. This is the first time Manchester and Peebles have played in 40 years. The Hounds did have some success by scoring 4 touchdowns. Trey Spears ran for two touchdowns and Mason scored a 60-yard run and a 20-yard run for a touchdown.

The Hounds played Eastern October 11th. Alex Walters scored a touchdown and Trey Spears caught it for the 2-point conversion. The final score was Eastern 48 Hounds 8.



The Manchester varsity cheer squad recently iust competed in the Highland County Fair competition and brought home the 2nd place trophy out of 4 schools.




